	12	does not recognize such marriages. Maud, child no. 2, must be older than her brother William, and could hardly have been born later than 1163, since she had												
	13	a daughter, Alice d'Eu, who was married to Ralph (Raoul) de Lusignan in 1191, and probably had children in turn as early as 1195. Therefore the claim that the above												
	14	wife, Isabel, married Hamelin Plantagenet between 1163 and 1165, may still be a												
	15	off a year or two.
